
RESPONSE TO BIDDERS' REQUESTS FOR CALRIFICATIONS

Supply, Installation, Testing, Commissioning, Training And Maintenance Of Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) System And Biometric System

No	Request for Clarification	Clarification Provided
1	What is the type of cable required and how many meters?	<p>The type of cable is not specified. It should be compatible with the CCTV system that that the bidder proposes to supply and install.</p> <p>The meters (length) is not specified. It shall be dependent on how the cameras shall be positioned by the bidder. Bidders are required to go and work out the estimates at the Roads Authority Headquarters.</p> <p>Bidders should propose the type of CCTV system and determine the materials required based on their survey of the site.</p>
2	Having gone for the site survey at the Roads Authority Headquarters in Lilongwe, the number of cameras needed is 15. In the bidding document, it is indicated 18 cameras for all the three sites (Roads Authority Headquarters, and Regional Offices (North, Centre and South). The 18 cameras are not enough. Don't you need to add more cameras for both dome and bullet cameras to cover all the sites?	<p>The site required to install CCTV cameras is only the Roads Authority Headquarters in Lilongwe.</p> <p>The number of cameras needed for the Roads Authority Headquarters is 18 as specified in the document.</p>
3	Are there any specifications for the 24 Port Power over Ethernet Switch and 36" TV Screen?	There are no specifications provided on the Switch and the TV screen as these have to be compatible with the CCTV system that the bidder proposes to supply and install and which should be suitable for the site.
4	On TV screen you wrote Supply of a (2) 36" TV screen for viewing. Does the (2) mean quantity needed is two?	Yes. The quantity of TVs required is 2No.

No	Request for Clarification	Clarification Provided
5	In order for us to be specific on the total length of cable needed and man hours needed for the installations, there is need to check the installation site. Have you arranged or can you accept a request for a site visit?	Yes. All bidders are required to go and visit the site to familiarize themselves with the scope of the work.
