Invitation for Prequalification

PREQUALIFICATION FOR URGENT AND EMERGENCY WORKS

1. Scope of work

- 1.1. The country experiences several bridge and road washaways due to heavy floods, particularly in the floodplains and the mountainous areas. In order to address such and other eventualities, there is a need to urgently mobilise contractors and other resources to avoid disrupting accessibility for the general public on the public road network.
- 1.2. A shortlist list of contractors will be drawn from a pool of contractors that will be developed through the prequalification process. This will ensure that support resources can be mobilised quickly through use of restricted tender procedures.

2. Source of funding

- 2.1. Roads Authority annually secures funding for recurrent expenditures and it intends to apply part of the funds to payments under emergency and urgent works for Roads Authority (RA) for implementation in the 2022/2023 and 2023/2024 financial years.
- 2.2. Roads Authority is inviting contractors registered with the National Construction Industry Council of Malawi to submit their pre-qualification information for execution of emergency and urgent works. The works shall be undertaken on all designated roads in the country.

3. Bidding procedures

- 3.1. Bidding will be conducted in accordance with the open tendering procedures contained in the Public Procurement and Disposal of Public Assets (PPDA) Act (2017) and the Public Procurement Regulations of 2020 of the Government of the Republic of Malawi and is open to all bidders from eligible source countries. All eligible contractors are required to be registered with the National Construction Industry Council of Malawi (NCIC) in the Civil Category and have renewed their membership for the 2022 financial year.

- 3.2. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information and inspect the Prequalification Documents at the (address below) from 08:00 to 12:00 hours and 14:00 to 17:00 hours from Monday to Friday, excluding public holidays from **5th October 2022**.
