The Government of Malawi has received funding from the World Bank for partial recovery construction work and through the Roads Authority (RA) intends to use part of that funding towards the cost of consultancy services for Design Review and Construction Supervision of Washed away Road Sections and Drainage Structures on Chingo - Makanjira (S129) Road in Mangochi.

The main objective of the construction is to restore and improve connectivity between Mangochi and Makanjila all the way to the western part of Mozambique. The connectivity will facilitate traffic flow and enhance transport efficiency and result in huge transport cost savings for the road users and the economy in general since with the current scenario, transporters are spending many hours and even cut off especially during the rainy season.

The Roads Authority therefore wishes to competitively engage a suitable consulting engineering firm to conduct a Design Review and Construction Supervision of Washed away Road Sections and Drainage Structures on Chingo - Makanjira (S129) Road in Mangochi.

The Roads Authority now invites eligible consulting firms ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information

demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. The shortlisting criteria are:

- 1) Core business of the firm(s) and years in business.
- 2) Relevant experience, which should specifically include the following:
  - (a). Experience in carrying out design designs, design validation, review and construction supervision of road works contracts
  - (b). Experience in preparation of bidding documents following FIDIC Conditions of Contracts
  - (c). Experience in Monitoring the Implementation of Resettlement Action Plans and ES Management Strategies and Implementation Plans (ES-MSIP)
  - (d). Experience in similar assignment in the Sub-Saharan African region or any other region with similar environment
- 3) Technical and Managerial capability of the firm (Provide only the structure of the organization, general qualifications. and number of key staff. Do not provide CV of the staff). Key Experts will not be evaluated at the short-listing stage.

Interested consultants should provide only reference which are responding to the shortlisting Criteria.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to Section III, paragraphs, 3.14, 3.16, and 3.17 of the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" dated September 2023 ("Procurement Regulations"), setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.

Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications, but should indicate clearly whether the association is in the form of a joint venture and/or a sub-consultancy. In the case of a joint venture, all the partners in the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract, if selected.

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Quality Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method set out in the Procurement Regulations.
