1. Source of funding and scope

- 1.1. The Roads Authority (RA) has secured funds from the Malawi Government for the procurement of selected road capacity improvement / upgrading / rehabilitation works commencing in the 2023 2024 financial year. The RA intends to apply part of the funds to cover eligible payments for the proposed works.
- 1.2. The RA now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the Upgrading of Rumphi Nyika Chitipa Road, Phase 1: Bolero Bembe Section

2. Bidding procedures

- 2.1. Bidding will be conducted in accordance with the open national tendering procedures contained in the Public Procurement and Disposal of Public Assets (PPDA) Act (2017) and the Public Procurement Regulations of 2020 of the Government of the Republic of Malawi and is open to all bidders from eligible source countries. All eligible bidders are required to show evidence of registration with the National Construction Industry Council of Malawi (NCIC) in the Unlimited Civil Engineering Category and have renewed their membership for the current financial year.

2.3. **Bidding Documents**: Interested Contractors may download the Bidding Documents from the Roads Authority Website <u>www.ra.org.mw</u>. Bidders are required to purchase the

bidding documents. Bidders should note that while access to the bidding documents is free, bids received will only be considered for evaluation if accompanied by proof of deposit or transfer of an amount of MWK50,000.00.

- 2.5. Bids **shall** be valid for a period of **120 days** from the date of opening.
- 2.6. **Requests** for clarification on bidding documents or general questions must be sent in writing to the address in (2.2) above at least **7 calendar days** before the tender closing date.
- 2.7. **Site visits and pre-bid meetings:** The RA shall not arrange any official site visits and pre-bid meetings, but all prospective bidders must visit the site to familiarise themselves with the existing conditions at the project site.
- 2.8. The **Roads** Authority is not bound to accept the lowest or any bidder.

3. Submission of bids

- 3.1. Bids must be delivered to Roads Authority Head Office in sealed envelopes with a clearly marked Procurement Reference Number and Contract Details at or before 10:00 Hours Local Time on Thursday, 12th December, 2023.
- 3.2. All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Securing Declaration Form in the format as provided in Section 4 of the bidding documents. Late bids shall be rejected. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend at 11:00 Hours Local Time on 12th December, 2023.
