1. Project description and source of funding

- 1.1. The Roads Authority (RA) has secured funds from the Malawi Government for the procurement of selected road upgrading / rehabilitation works commencing in the 2023 2024 financial year. The RA intends to apply part of the funds to cover eligible payments for the proposed consultancy services.
- 1.2. The RA now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for the supervision consultancy services for the Upgrading of Rumphi Nyika Chitipa Road, Phase 1: Bolero Bembe Section.

2. Bidding procedures

- 2.1. Bidding will be conducted in accordance with the open national tendering procedures contained in the Public Procurement and Disposal of Public Assets (PPDA) Act (2017) and the Public Procurement Regulations of 2020 of the Government of the Republic of Malawi and is open to all eligible bidders. All eligible bidders are required to show evidence of registration with the National Construction Industry Council of Malawi (NCIC) and will have renewed their membership for the current financial year.

- 2.3. **Request for Proposal (RfP):** Interested eligible firms may download the RfP from the Roads Authority Website www.ra.org.mw. Bidders are required to purchase the RfP. Bidders should note that while access to the RfP is free, proposals received will only be considered for evaluation if accompanied by proof of deposit or transfer of an amount of MWK30,000.00.

- 2.5. Proposals shall be valid for a period of 120 days from the date of opening.
- 2.6. Requests for clarification on Request for Proposals or general questions must be sent in writing to the address in (2.2) above at least **7 calendar days** before the tender closing date.
- 2.7. Pre-proposal meetings: The RA shall not arrange a pre-proposal meeting.

3. Evaluation of technical proposals

- 3.1. Consultants will be evaluated on the basis of compliance with the requirements stated in TORs. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services:
 - Field of specialization of the firm
 - Experience in carrying out specific assignments in the last 10 years.
 - Technical and Managerial capability of the firm. (Provide the structure of the organization, general qualifications and experience, and number of key staff);
 - Adequacy of the Technical approach and methodology to undertake the assignment;
 - Key Experts' Qualifications and Competence for the assignment;
 - Experience in similar working conditions.
- 3.2. Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications, but should indicate clearly whether the association is in the form of a joint venture and/or a sub-consultancy. In the case of a joint venture, all partners in the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable for the entire contract.
- 3.3. The capacity of the bidders shall be checked against current commitments with the Roads Authority.

4. Submission and opening of technical proposals

Proposals must be delivered to the address in 2.2 on or before 12th December 2023 at 11.00 hours Central African Time and late bids will be rejected. Thereafter proposals will be opened in the presence of bidders who choose to attend the bid opening session.
